PARENT ROTA

- For the junior section of the club to run smoothly we require help from parents.
- A condition of membership is that parents help. If we do not have help, we would be unable to provide training for juniors.

- Maureen Kelly compiles the rota and it will be posted on the WhatsApp group.
- Changes to the rota are the responsibility of the parents.

ROLES OF PARENT WHEN VOLUNTEERING

- A supporting one.
- No running experience is necessary.
- Mainly to provide an extra set of hands in case something unexpected happens.
- Coaches deal with issues while the parent helper watches the kids.
- Parents can also get involved a bit with training by helping lay cones, watch finish lines and of course provide encouragement to the kids.

TRAINING

- Training is held Monday & Thursday 7-8pm. Children are expected to be ready to start at 7pm.
- They should arrive promptly and sign in. Payment is £1 per session and should be brought each night.
- It is important that they wear appropriate athletic gear.

 up.
- They should only attend training if they are able to run and keen to take part.
